Hallelujah! Praise the Lamb!

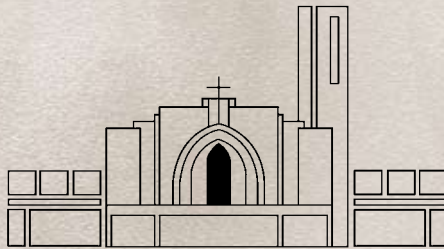
Some of us stay at the cross,
